We would like to make this into an area where you can sit and chat in the heart of the village, new benches should be with us shortly.

New planters have also been purchased for the Heritage Garden and entrances to the village and we are appealing for donations of compost and bedding plants to fill these up before they are planted for the summer.

We are also looking for an old “plough” or farming implement that can sit alongside the coal truck in the Heritage Garden to reflect the village’s farming history. If you happen to have a spare one you no longer need and would be willing to donate it to the Heritage Garden, we would love to hear from you.

We are also looking at utilising the old William Lee Memorial Park gates in this area possibly with some wrought iron “lace” panels to commemorate the birth of the stocking machine. Any ideas on how this might look or work would be gratefully received.
